Captain Crist was killed by a Confederate sharpshooter at Totpotomy, May 30,1864.1st Sergeant Thomas W.Bradley was promoted to 1st Lieut. to Captain, brevetted Major, U.S. V.Received the Congressional medal of honor. Wounded at Gettysburg, at the Wilderness; and at Boydton Road. He was mustered out June 3,1865. Gouveneer M.Legg was wounded at the Wilderness George Butters died a prisoner of war. Captured at Spottsylvania. William Henry Brown promoted to sergeant. Wounded at Chancellor-villed, at the Wilderness and Spottsylvania.
